



## Have Not Been Active Since 2021? Comeback Home Today?



The Coming Back Home initiative started early in October and will conclude on December 31, 2023. The Come Back Home Membership Incentive allows Brothers who have been non-financial since 2021 and have not previously participated in a two-for-one incentive an opportunity to pay both their 2024 international and regional dues. Those Brothers that make the payment will receive a full year's credit for 2023 and 2024!
